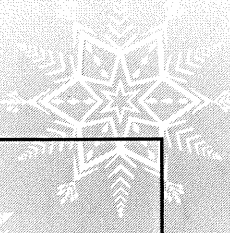
Counselor Highlight!


